Subject : Implementation of Govt. decision on recommendations of 6th Central Pay Commission.

Summary: 1. Rationalization of casualty Pensionary Award to Armed Forces Officers & PBORS retired / discharged / died / invalided out from service prior to 01-01-2006. (Disability & SFP Pensioners).

2. Revision of pay Scale HAG in respect of Civilian Pensioner for modified Parity.

3. Revision of pension of Pre 01-01-2006 Military Nursing Service Officers Retirees & Family Pensioners - Modified parity to "MNS" Pensioners.

4. Supplementary Schedules for releasing 60% arrears of 6thCPC to Defence Civilians / Armed Forces Pensioners and Family Pensioners.

Consequent on receipt of Govt. orders on recommendations on 6th Central Pay Commission for Disability Pensioners, Special Family Pensioners, MNS Pensioners and Civilian Pensioners of the rank of PCDA, software has been developed to revise and calculate arrears of pension and family pension. Orders have also been received for payment of second installment of arrears of pension on account of Government's decision on the recommendations of 6th CPC. Therefore, the arrears up to August 2008 i.e. 40% of arrears up to August 2008 & Arrear from September 2008 to August 2009, to the affected pensioners (Disability Pensioners, Special Family Pensioners, MNS Pensioners and Civilian Pensioners of the rank of PCDA) will be paid through supplementary schedules. Balance 60% of arrears will also be paid along with the arrears recorded in the History Master in these cases.

2. Software is developed for releasing second installment of arrears of pension i.e. balance 60% of the total arrears on account of implementation of Govt. decision on the recommendations of the 6thCPC to Defence Civilians / Armed Forces Pensioners and Family Pensioners. These arrears will also be paid through supplementary schedules generated separately for civilian pensioners and Armed Forces Pensioners. **DPDOs should check the arrears where Modified Parity is given. Modified parity is indicated in the schedule by “MP” Flag.**

3. Regarding rationalization of casualty Pensionary Award for the Armed Forces Officers and Personnel Below Officers Rank retired/discharged/invalidated out from service prior to 1.1.2006 i.e. Disability Pensioners, rates of disability element is revised as per Ministry of Defence letter no. 16(6)/2008(1)/D(Pension/Policy) dated 04-05-2009. The difference on account of revision is calculated and paid thru programs PDDISCAL & PDDISPRT.

Following points are brought to your notice

- While revising the disability pension of Post 1996 cases, the benefit of broad banding is allowed. In other words, disability element is fixed after considering degree of disability from the master. The DE is fixed @ 50% of Disability Element for the degrees from 20% to 50%. Where Disability Degree is more than 50% but less than or equal to 75%, Disability element is fixed @ 75% of Disability Element. Where Disability Degree is more than 75%, Disability element is fixed @ 100% of Disability Element. **This fixation should be checked by the DPDOs in all cases with reference to original PPO as broad banding rule is applicable to the cases which are invalided out of service and there is no indication in the RNPDS Masters for extraction of such cases.**
- During the Test run of DPDO Gurgaon, it is noticed that a disability pensioner with Disability rank of Hony. Nb. Sub., Disability degree as 20% and Disability Element as Rs.701/- is revised to Rs.860/- (20% of Rs.4300 applicable for JCOs). It shows that disability amount, calculated on the basis of RO Code & Rank given in RNPDS masters, does not tally with the existing disability amount being paid to the pensioners as per PPO/Corr.PPOs. Therefore, all arrears should be checked to ensure that disability rank and degree in the RNPDS Masters are correct and

that the arrears has been worked out correctly. Remarks are given in the schedules for identification of such cases and DPDOs are required to propose correction thru GCF for actual Disability Element after rectifying arrear in the schedule.

- There can also be errors of revision as reflected in the schedules generated for DPDO Gurgaon wherein a case of disability pension was revised by applying fitment formula erroneously from Rs.1163 to Rs.2630 as revision-flag was “U” in the Master. “U” flag shows that pension does not include the dearness pension whereas Rs.1163/- was inclusive of dearness pension and flag should be changed to “D” It is revised as per current order to the amount of Rs. 1755. It is a case of overpayment in past and therefore, arrears worked out in negative because of incorrect data. Remarks are given in the schedules for identification of such cases and DPDOs are required to propose correction thru GCF for actual Disability Element and propose demand for recovery.
- **All cases must be checked and verified w.r.t. PC files before making payment thru Supplementary Schedules.**

4. Similarly, in case of revision of Special Family Pension as per Ministry of Defence letter no. 16(6)/2008(1)/D(Pension/Policy) dated 04-05-2009, **all cases must be checked and verified before making payment thru Supplementary Schedules as error in pentype may lead to wrong (over/under) payment of arrears.**

5. As separate software has been developed for :-

- (a) Disability
- (b) SFP
- (c) MNS Modified Parity
- (d) Modified Parity for HAG pay-scale officers in r/o Civilians
- (e) Release of 60% arrears for Civilian Pensioners
- (f) Release of 60% arrears for Armed Forces Pensioners

All supplementary schedules, releasing payment of 40% of arrears and arrears accumulated from September 2008 to August 2009, will be printed first. After that, Software for releasing 60% arrears of 6thCPC to Defence Civilians / PBORs Pensioners and Family Pensioners will be executed.

Note :- DPDOs should check the arrears where Modified Parity is given.

- DPDOs are required to take backup of RNPDS Master after the processing of all supplementary schedules but before regular processing of pension schedules for the month of September 2009.

Note :- It is brought to the notice of all DPDOs that the outstanding demand has been recovered from the 60% arrears. If demand is more than the arrears, remaining demand is recorded in the pay master for recovery in coming months.
