Subject : Implementation of Govt. decision on recommendations of 6th Central Pay Commission - Revision of Pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces Pensioners / Family Pensioners

*Summary:
Printing of supplementary schedules revision of pension and disbursement of arrears thereof on implementation of recommendation of 6th Central Pay Commission*

Consequent on receipt of Govt. decision on the implementation of 6th Central Pay Commission for revision of pension / family pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces Pensioners, software has been developed to revise and calculate arrears of pension and family pension and to facilitate the speedy disbursement thereof through Supplementary Schedules in the month of December 2008. The arrears up to November 2008 (40% of arrears up to August 2008 & Arrear for September, October and November 2008) to the affected pensioners will be paid through supplementary schedules and revised pension paid through regular pension schedules for December 2008.

2. As per the orders Government orders on 6th CPC recommendations, modified parity is to be given to armed forces personnel on the basis of rank last held. However, RNPDS Master is capturing "rank for pension" for the pensioners. The problem stated above was discussed in the meeting with JT. CGDA(AT-II) on 2-12-2008 and according to the decision given, "rank for pension" will be taken as "rank last held" and pension will be revised as per fitment formula subject to condition given under modified parity. The rank last held will be subsequently verified by the respecting DPDOs as correct and

in the event of change, if any, the correction under GCF will be proposed by the DPDOS for the same.

3. The revision of pension is done duly taking into account the modified parity tables attached as Annexures II & III to the Govt. of India order dated 11-11-2008 for service as well as for family pensioners. **However, there is no distinction in the family pension granted to family of PBOR or to the family of Officer in the RNPDS System. So, these cases cannot be identified by the system and their family pension cannot be revised as per modified parity given in Annexure II (for family of officers). However, pension will be revised as per modified parity given under Annexure III (For Family Pensioners) by the program. In other words, all family pensioners (whether of officers or of PBORs) will be revised under modified parity given in Annexure III only.**
4. 4. While revising the pension for disability pensioners as per Para 9 & 9.1 of the Govt. Order dated 11-11-2008, it is intimated that service element is revised as per fitment formula subject to the modified parity. The minimum limit of Rs.3500 will apply to service element of disability pension only. Disability element is revised separately as per fitment formula subject to the minimum limit of Rs. 3500 for 100% degree of disability.
5. 5. For cases where disability date upto is discontinued before 20080801, it is intimated that disability element is revised taking the DR-Flag as “U” Flag for such cases wherein “disability date upto” is greater than 20060101 but discontinued before 20060701. The date 20060701 is the date of implementation of One Rank One Pension Order and thereafter disability element is revised as per the existing DA- Flag. For rest of the cases, exiting DR-Flag is taken for revision of disability element.
6. 6. The same procedure is followed in WIP & WIE cases while developing the program. However, it is not clear whether minimum limit of 3500 will be applied to WIE where WIE is drawn in isolation as clearly mention in orders for cases drawing disability element in isolation. It is mentioned that in WIE cases, degree of disability is not given in the PPO.
7. 7. It is, further, intimated that family pension is also revised for the cases where family pension is commenced after 01-01-2006 but the deceased was retired/discharged

prior to 01-01-2006 on the basis of last digits of PPO No and the series. Using this criteria for finding out these cases may result in exclusion of some cases. These leftover cases may be identified by the DPDOs and correction will be proposed by them.

8. 8. It is also intimated that Pension for Pentype “ABS” is not revised. No order has been received for revising pension for ABS pensioners. Revision of pension for Pentype “SDP” and “DSF” is done on the basis of fitment formula and is to be verified by taking the both pensions together and then revising the same, as these are divided portion of one service pension. Similarly, cases are revised for divided share of family pension cases (“DFP” & “DLP”) using fitment formula but this revision is to be verified because total of revised pension is to be divided among the all recipients according to percentage share of them.

9. **There is no distinction for the families of Officers and PBORs so the modified parity will not be given as per Annexure II (for family of officers). However, pension will be revised as per modified parity given under Annexure III (For Family Pensioners) by the program. In other words, all family pensioners (whether of officers or of PBORs) will be revised under modified parity given in Annexure III only.**

10. Also refers HQrs. Instruction order No. 99 Dated 14/11/2008. **DPDOs are required to execute program PDRESTOR for bringing date of birth field in PBORs cases back to their original status.**

11. **Responsibility is entrusted upon the DPDO to pre-audit the Date of birth / arrears of pensioner granted Additional Pension w.r.t original documents of the pensioner in 100% cases before releasing the arrears.**

11. The sequence of processing for supplementary pension schedules under modified parity are as under :

- Execute Program PDRESTOR that will revert original status date of birth field. It will ask history master of November 2008 i.e. master before processing of December 2008 and previous history master of September 2008.
- Update RNPDS Masters again with the GCF corrections file (as per HQrs Instruction Order No. 97 dated 25-08-2008) proposing changes in the date of birth / age field of pensioners for PBORs.

- Take a back up of Masters. This can be done by transferring masters to a separate temporary directory so that in cases of any error in further processing, masters can be readily available and be copied to regular directory from this temporary directory.
- Execute Program PDSERCAL that will revise the pension as per fitment formula subject to modified parity for officers and PBORs and calculates arrears of revised pension and extracts all information in a file.
- Sort the extraction file on two keys at position 74 & 59. Lengths of keys are 6 & 7 respectively.
- Execute Program PDMODPRT to print the supplementary pension schedule for the affected cases.
- Execute Program PDSERCOMP to compile the payments made through supplementary schedules.
- Take a back up of Masters before regular processing of pension schedules for the month of Dec.2008. This may be done by transferring masters to a separate temporary directory.

12. RNPDS Software for printing of regular pension schedules for Dec. 2008 is being sent shortly.

Note1 : The Cheque for payment of arrears through Supplementary Schedules should be released positively by 20th December , 2008.

Note2 : Before releasing arrears of pension, the revision and arrears should be checked randomly by the DPDOs.
