Subject : Implementation of Govt. decision on recommendations of 6th Central Pay Commission - Revision of Pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces Pensioners / Family Pensioners & Civilian Case - Leftover cases.

Summary:
Printing of supplementary schedules of revision of pension and disbursement of arrears thereof on implementation of recommendation of 6th Central Pay Commission

Consequent on receipt of Govt. decision on the implementation of 6th Central Pay Commission for revision of pension / family pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces Pensioners, the revised software was sent to all the decentralized DPDOs and EDP centres in the month of September 2008 for civilians and in December 2008 for the PBORS to facilitate the speedy disbursement of revised pension/family pension and arrears thereof through Supplementary Schedules printed in respective months.

2. It is, further, intimated that civilian family pension is also revised for the cases where family pension is commenced after 01-01-2006 but the deceased was retired/discharged prior to 01-01-2006 on the basis of last digits of PPO No and the series. For revision of these cases and also for revision of consolidated pension as per orders of Modified Parity, a new program PDCIVCAL is being sent. This program will revise all cases of modified parity and family pension and other left over cases due to change of Pentye.

By using this criterion for finding out the family pension cases, some family pension cases may still be un-revised. It is advised that these leftover cases may be

identified by the DPDOs and revised manually and correction to update the RNPDS Master will be proposed thru PD6PCUPD program (already sent to you).

3. Due to lack of clarification of orders of Modified parity for the ranks of Subedar Major Hony Capt. and Subedar Major Hony Lt., pension of these ranks were revised as per fitment formula and were not given benefit of stepping up of pension as per modified parity. Similarly, pension, in case of some family pensioners, was also not revised as per modified parity because qualifying service field in these cases was blank.

In order to revise all these cases along with the other such type of leftover cases, if any, a new program PDSERCAL is being sent.

4. In addition to these programs, programs for extraction and printing of Annexure III & IV are also being sent herewith. **It is advised that print file of these annexures may be made and a soft copy of this file on CD be sent to PCDA(P) Allahabad. Hard copy of print file may become voluminous as a single page contains details of one pensioner and for 10000 pensioners, 10000 pages will be printed. However, a individual case may be printed by the DPDO and given to pensioner, as when pensioner turns ups and demand for this.**

5. Program ANNEX3EXT.GNT & ANNEX4EXT.GNT will extract the file for printing Annexure-III for civilian cases and Annexure-IV for PBORS cases respectively. Simultaneously these programs will post Pension, old DR flag and Disability Pension as on 1-12006 for future MIS and calculation purposes. These extracted files will be printed by using program ANNEX3PRT.GNT and ANNEX4PRT.GNT respectively.

6. **The sequence of processing for the month of January 2009 is as under:**

- Execute Program ANNEX3EXT (with paymaster of September 2008). Sorted file of extraction cases made in the month of October by using program PD6PCCAL will be used in this program. No sorting will be done on extracted output file as details of each pensioner will be printed on single page.

- Execute ANNEX4EXT (with paymaster of November 2008). Sorted file of extraction cases made in the month of December by using program PDSERCAL will be used in this program. No sorting will be done on extracted output file as details of each pensioner will be printed on single page.

- Take a back up of Masters. This can be done by transferring masters to a separate temporary directory so that in case of any error in further processing, masters can be readily available and be copied to regular directory from this temporary directory.
- Execute PDCIVCAL for revision of pension of civilian cases as per Para 2 above.
- Sort the extraction file on two keys at position 74 & 59. Lengths of keys are 6 & 7 respectively.
- Execute Program PDCSVPRT to print the supplementary pension schedule for the affected civilian cases.
- Execute PDSERCAL for revision of pension of PBORs cases as per Para 3 above.
- Sort the extraction file on two keys at position 74 & 59. Lengths of keys are 6 & 7 respectively.
- Execute Program PDSERPRT to print the supplementary pension schedule for the affected PBORs cases.
- Execute Program PDCIVCOMP and PDSERCOMP to compile the payments made through supplementary schedules.
- Take a back up of Masters before regular processing of pension schedules for the month of January 2009. This may be done by transferring masters to a separate temporary directory.
- Execute programs for regular processing of pension schedules for the month of January 2009.
- Execute Programs ANNEX3PRT & ANNEX4PRT for making print-files of ANNEXURE III & IV as per Para 4 above.

12. It is informed to all concerned that

- **All New cases in the RNPDS Master should be incorporated after fixation of pension.**
- **Programs PD1R1PREV , PDFINIMP & PD1R1PMS will not be used.**
- **Revised programs of PDCORVAL and PDCORCRN for New Pension and DR Rates will be sent in the next month. Therefore arrears with respect to transaction code 12 may be incorrect and should be calculated manually and to be paid through transaction code 91.**

13. Any problem/discrepancy noticed after printing of schedules should invariably be sent thru E-Mail immediately for necessary remedial action.
