Subject : Implementation of Govt. decision on recommendations of 6th Central Pay Commission - Revision of Pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces Pensioners / Family Pensioners & Civilian Case – LTA Payment for Death Cases.

Summary:
Printing of schedules authorizing Tentative Life Time Arrears (LTA) arrears on revision of pension as per recommendation of 6th Central Pay Commission for Pensioners expired between Jan. 2006 & Nov. 2008.

Consequent on receipt of Govt. decision on the implementation of 6th Central Pay Commission for revision of pension / family pension of Pre-2006 Armed Forces and Civilians Pensioners, pension was revised and arrears thereof were paid to all PBORS and Civilians pensioners.

2. It is, now, decided to provide facility to DPDOs for speedy authorization of LTA payment to the claimant of deceased pensioners expired during Jan. 2006 to Nov. 2008. For implementation of this, new software is developed which will calculate tentative arrears up to the date of death, lying in the master. The revision of pension will be done on the basis of information deduced from last payment details available in the Monthly Master and schedule will be printed bank branch code wise and HO Number wise. In the schedule, date of death of the pensioner is also mentioned along with the other details. It is, therefore, required that DPDO should check the correctness of arrears with reference to PC files and keep ready the correct amount to be paid to LTA nominee so that on turning up of a claimant of deceased pensioner, DPDO will be able to prepare LTA Claim immediately with the help of this schedule as arrears have already been calculated checked.

3. **The sequence of processing for the calculation of arrears of Death cases is as under:**

- Make a separate directory for death cases (for e.g. DTH0409) and copy masters after the processing of April 2009.
 - Take backups from Jan. 2006 to Nov. 2008 and load files containing death cases (i.e. Tr-Code 02) from these backups in this separate directory DTH0409.
 - Combine all the correction files of death cases in one file using “CAT” command.
 - Execute Program PDCORVAL on the correction file for printing & checking of cases.
 - Execute program PDDTHUPD for updation of this file into history master.
 - Execute program **DTHCIVEX** for extraction & calculation of arrears for civilian death cases and program **DTHSEREX** for extraction & calculation of arrears for PBORs death cases.
 - Sort both the extraction files on two keys i.e. key at position 74 of length 6 and at position 59 of length 6.
 - Execute program **DTHCIVPR** for printing of schedule for tentative arrears of pension for civilian death cases and program **DTHSERPR** for printing of schedule for tentative arrears of pension for PBORs death cases.
 - Copy these masters for regular processing of pension schedules for the month of May 2009.
4. DPDOs are entrusted with the responsibility of verifying arrear claim of all death cases printed in the schedule because it has been noticed that information of death is received in DPDO after a long gap of time of death and the pension has been sent to bank even after the death of the pensioner. It is, therefore, entrusted upon the DPDOs to take into account, all these aspects before authorizing the LTA payment.
