Subject : Implementation of Govt. Orders on recommendations of 6th Central Pay Commission - Revision of Pension of Pre-2006 Civilian Pensioners / Family Pensioners

Summary:

- 1. Printing of supplementary schedules revision of pension and disbursement of arrears thereof on implementation of recommendation of 6th Central Pay Commission - Revision of Pre-2006 civilian pensioner/family pensioner.*
- 2. Program for conversion of age field to date of birth filed.*

Consequent upon receipt of Govt. Orders on the implementation of 6th Central Pay Commission for revision of pension of Pre-2006 civilian pensioners/family pensioners, circulated by PSA vide Circular no 57 dated 17-09-2008, provision is made in the RNPDS System to revise the pension / family pension of Pre-2006 Civilian Pensioners, to authorize additional pension to pensioners above 80 years of age and to calculate the arrears thereof automatically so as to facilitate the speedy disbursement of pension and arrears through Supplementary Schedules in the month of October 2008. Regular Pension Schedules for October 2008 will be printed after printing of Supplementary Schedules.

2. Accordingly, Programs have been developed for revision & calculation of arrears of pension on account of 6th CPC recommendations. The pension of civilian pensioners / family pensioners pertaining to the period prior to 1.1.2006 is revised and additional pension is authorized (wherever applicable). Further, the arrears are computed duly taking into account several criteria for example their date of re-employment & discharge, enhance rate of pension, normal rate of pension and normal rate date from. The due and

drawn for these pensioners has been prepared and 40% of net arrears till August 2008 plus arrear for September 2008 are being paid through supplementary schedule.

3. As per Para 4.5 of DP&PW OM no. 38/37/08-P&PW(A).PT.I Dated 03-10-2008, the additional quantum of pension / family pension, on attaining age of 80 years or above, would be admissible from the 1st day of the month in which his date of birth falls. Arrears of pension / family pension is, therefore, calculated accordingly and no partial calculation is done for the month in which pensioner attains the age of 80 years.

4. Additional pension is calculated on date of birth where complete date of birth is given and not for the cases where age is given in the date of birth field. For cases, where age is given or incorrect date of birth exists in the master, DPDOs have already been advised to propose corrections to update RNPDS Master as per this office Instruction Order no. 97 dated 25-08-2008. If said list is ready, DPDOs are required to update RNPDS Master with this list and **before executing programs for generation of supplementary schedules, Program PDAGCONV will be executed** which will convert age into date of birth. This program will convert age into date of birth field by subtracting age from year part of date of commencement giving year part of date of birth and taking month from “date of commencement field” as month in the “date of birth” field & date from “date of commencement field” as date in the “date of birth” field thereby completing 8 digits field of date of birth. There is, however, deviation in the procedure for conversion of age into date of birth as described in Para 5.4 in previous Instruction Order bearing no. 97 dated 25-08-2008.

5. It is informed that no provision is made in the programs to check whether revised pension is more than the 50% of minimum of the revised pay band and pension is revised as per fitment formula given in the orders. As per Para 11 of DP&PW OM Dated 01-09-2008 the heads of department are responsible to issue Corr. PPOs where revised pension is less than 50% of the minimum of the revised pay band and grade pay. Hence DPDOs should wait for the revised PPOs to extend further benefits in such cases.

6. It is intimated that in cases where two pensions have been granted to a pensioner, pension of pensioner is revised as per Para 5.1 of DP&PW OM Dated 03-10-2008, the floor ceiling of Rs. 3500 will apply individually to the civil and military pension. Further,

in case, a person in receipt of pension as well as family pension, the floor ceiling of Rs. 3500 will apply individually to such pension and family pension.

7. The regular software for the RNPDS System will be modified and sent to all concerned incorporating the changes made in the masters due to implementation of the provisions of 6th CPC shortly.

8. The Module for printing of supplementary schedules includes the two programs i.e. PD6PCCAL and PD6PCPRT. The program PD6PCCAL revises the pension and calculates arrears of pension, records arrears of pension in the master for payment of 2nd installment of arrears in the next financial year. Arrears for the September 2008 is calculated separately and paid through Supplementary Schedules along with 40% of net arrears (from 01-01-2006 to August 2008). From October 2008, these cases will be paid as revised as per 6th CPC.

9. As per Para 3 of DP&PW OM no. 38/37/08-P&PW(A).PT.II Dated 03-10-2008, the period of 10 years for payment of enhanced family pension will count from the date of death of the Govt. servant and this would apply in respect of whom the family was receiving enhanced family pension as on 1-1-2006. The program takes care of this aspect and arrears will be calculated according to this provision.

10. This program also changes DR-Flag for revised cases from “X”, “D” or “U” to “Z”. This will govern the dearness relief, in these cases, at revised rate of 16% as per Govt. Orders.

11. Execution of this Module is given below :

- PD6PCCAL will revise the affected cases, calculate their arrears of pension and extracts a file.

- The extraction file will be sorted on two keys at position 74 & 59. Lengths of keys are 6 & 7 respectively.
- PD6PCPRT will print the supplementary schedules. These schedules will release arrears for 33 months i.e. from Jan.'2006 to Sep.'2008.
